Langkawi is a cluster of 99 islands and is part of Malaysia. It is located at the north-western part of peninsular Malaysia and on the Andaman Sea. It is adjacent to and south of Thailand. The islands are separated from the main land of Malaysia by the water channel known as the Strait of Malacca. Rebak Island is one of the 99 islands and located away from the hustle and bustle of the main town. The Marina is connected via boat transfer from Langkawi main island which can be reached via air and ferry.

**Unregistered contractors and workers are NOT allowed to work in the marina.** If service of unlisted contractors is required, permission from the Marina Office is needed before commencing the work. The list is to facilitate the boaties without any obligation of the marina. Boaties to communicate directly with the contractor. For the foreign citizen, valid working permit and valid registered company is required.

## THE ARRIVAL

- Make sure the documents of Vessel Registration & Insurance and valid passport of all traveller and crews are available for registration.
- E-mail or call Marina Office for availability check OR refer with the listed contractor
- Radio us via VHF Ch 69 when 30 minutes to reach the Marina so that we can welcome you for the right berth.
- Registration and advance payment to be made at the Marina Office

## THE BILLING

- The berthing fee is to be paid in advance based on the package, either daily, monthly, 3 months, 6 months or 365 days.
- The utilities charges will be billed on a monthly basis via e-mail. The payment needs to be made within 7 days upon receiving of the statement.

## THE SCHEDULED FERRY

- The ferry schedule is available at both terminals. Be at the terminal 10 minutes before departure.
- The registered boaties and family are eligible for complimentary ferry service but the other guests and visitors are subject to the fee of RM10 imposed at the terminal.
- To log the name at the terminal as and when taking the ferry.
- To wear a life jacket while in the boat.
- Only hand carry items of a reasonable size is allowed on the boat. Any oversized parcels and package are subject to additional fees.
- The below items are not allowed on the passenger ferry and a private boat/ferry will be required for:
  - Flammable item which includes but not limited to petrol, diesel, turpentine, LPG gas and vehicle batteries.
  - Oversized and overweight items such as outboard engine, timber & wood, steels & bars.
  - Pets and durian fruit, unless in sealed and closed container

## THE PACKAGE, PARCEL AND COURIER

- Any personal letters, parcel, packages and courier delivered to the Cenang Jetty Terminal will be accepted by the Resort's Security Team with free of liability.
- It is advisable that valuable items are to be received personally at the Cenang Jetty Terminal.
- All small size items will then be transported to Resort's Security post for your collection.
- Free cargo boat to Main Island twice a week on **Monday, Wednesday** and **Saturday** for heavy and oversize items. Owners need to monitor their own items during the process. Any question for cargo boat can contact Mr. Rusli at +6012 4176965

## THE RESORT'S FACILITIES

- It is advisable to pre-book for Dining, SPA and Tennis Court to avoid disappointment.
- The registered Marina Residents are allowed to use the swimming pool during its operation hours. Below guidelines must be adhered to:
  - No outside food and drinks are allowed around the pool and beach.
  - Proper swimming attire to be worn.
  - To shower and rinse before entering the pool.
  - Not to bring the pool towel out from the pool parameter.
- No pet is allowed around the Resort. It has to be strictly on the boat. However, the dog is not allowed within Marina and Resort.
- The Resort provides pack food delivery to your boat, please call the Food & Beverage department via the resort's main line.
- If you are chartering the boat for commercial use, your guests are not allowed to use the pool. However, they are allowed to patronize the F&B outlet subject to availability.
- Any gathering for more than 10 persons requires a consent from Resort's management.

## THE SAFETY & SERENITY OF THE MARINA

- Not to keep anything on the dock. The dock should be free from any obstruction.
- No maintenance works are allowed on the dock.
- The Marina Management will provide trolleys and wheel barrows at the Security post for transporting items from the Jetty to your boat. This has to be returned back right away after use please.
- To alert the Marina Office at Ch 69 if any potential hazard and risk is discovered. This includes the unauthorized entry to the dock.
- No vehicles (motorized, battery operated or scooters) allowed to enter the dock without consent. A bicycle cannot be ridden on the dock, but can be pushed and parked on the boat.
- Strictly no garbage dumping in the water or ground. Bins are provided at gazette areas. Garbage to be in the locked bins to avoid monkeys.
- The use of any space within Marina and Resort for any gathering, maintenance or storage, require approval from the management. Unless it is at gazette areas within Hardstand.
- All person permitted to do any kind of maintenance work on any vessel in the boatyard must take all reasonable step to minimize any potential nuisance. Owners shall be responsible to ensure no spillage of any waste material. Surrounding area must be kept clean and tidy at all times. No debris from any work performed on boats may be allowed to contaminate the yard or marina/bay water. No boat will be launched unless the area related to the boat has been cleaned.
- Prior written permission Rebak marina needs to be obtained before any work can be done by any outside contractors.
- Dispose of paint cans, drop cloths, oil, gas, diesel, solvent, paint, bilge water, cleansers and hazardous or potentially hazardous waste in a lawful manner. Please clean up after yourselves and keep the area under the boat clean. Trash cans are provided so please use them.
- Unprotected painting, sanding and grinding within the boatyard is strictly prohibited. Sanding and painting must be done with the care and covers should be erected at all times.
- Tampering with cradle arms or props is extremely dangerous and must not be attempted.
- Working hours for contractors will be from 08.00am until 17.00 unless prior permission has been obtained by marina office.
- All person entering the boatyard for any reason do so entirely at their own risk.
